To keep the competition as open as possible you may if you wish shoot your rounds one distance down from those stated for your group. These scores will only count towards the handicap award. Compound bow scores will only count towards the handicap score. More information on handicaps is available on the club website. If you do not have a handicap yet I will calculate it when 3 scores are submitted and apply to those 3 scores.

Seniors

This year's summer competition will be based on set rounds. Your score will be the total of your best 1 or 2 of each of the rounds listed. There will be an award for overall score winner and handicap score winner.

National 60yrd/50yrd best 2 rounds

Warwick 60yrd/50yrd best 2 rounds

Western 60yrd/50yrd best round

(50yrd/40yrd for handicap only)

Juniors (under 18)

This year's summer competition will be based on set rounds. Your score will be the total of your best 1 or 2 of each of the rounds listed. There will be an award for overall score winner and handicap score winner.

Short National 50yrd/40yrd best 2 rounds

Short Warwick 50yrd/40yrd best 2 rounds

Short Western 50yrd/40yrd best round

(40yrd/30yrd for handicap only)

Juniors under 13

This year's summer competition will be based on set rounds. Your score will be the total of your best 1 or 2 of each of the rounds listed. There will be an award for overall score winner and handicap score winner.

Junior National 40yrd/30yrd best 2 rounds

Junior Warwick 40yrd/30yrd best 2 rounds

Junior Western 40yrd/30yrd best round

(30yrd/20yrd for handicap only)

Bent Stick Class

Introduced for those of you with bent sticks (longbow), you know who you are. Handicap scores only. Same structure as other class but at much much shorter distances.

Short National 50yrd/40yrd best 2 rounds

Short Warwick 50yrd/40yrd best 2 rounds

Short Western 50yrd/40yrd best round

(40yrd/30yrd for handicap only)

General Rules

You may submit as many scores as you wish as long as it's not less than 1 of each round.

Only one score may be submitted per calendar day.

Only 6 sighters before the round on the day therefore it must be the first round shot that day.

Each round must be shot in one session.

All rounds must be shot at the club field.

The competition will run from 1st May until one week before the AGM.

Score sheets are available on the club website and in the shed on the records notice board.
